St. Johns River to Sea Loop Trail along Myrtle Avenue from 10th Street to Lytle Avenue (State Road 44)

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation is developing plans to build approximately 1.2 miles of multi-use trail. The trail is proposed along Myrtle Avenue from 10th Street to Lytle Avenue (also known as State Road 44) in New Smyrna Beach. This project is part of the St. John's River to Sea Loop Trail.

Final design is scheduled to be completed in March of 2023. The project is funded for construction and is anticipated to begin in the fall of 2023.

Project Details

The trail will be 12 feet wide and will be constructed a minimum of 5 feet from the edge of the roadway. Between 10th Street and Joel Street, the trail will be on the west side of the road, and between Joel Street and Lytle Avenue, the trail will be on the east side of the road.

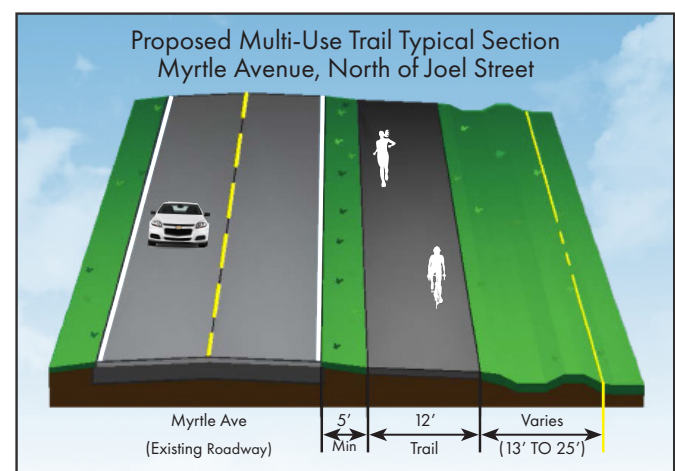
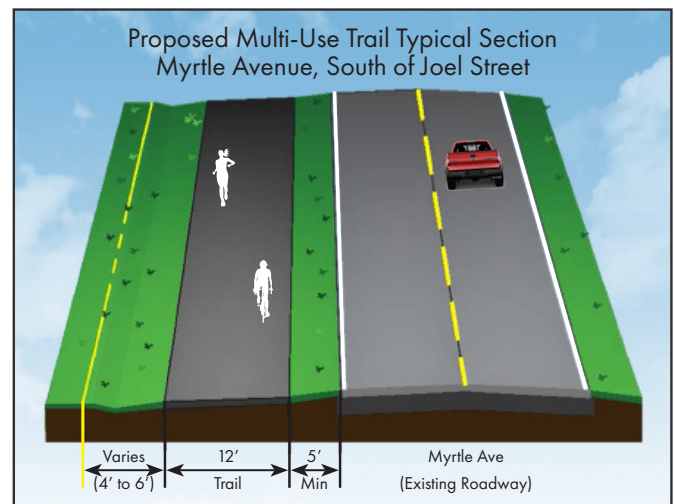

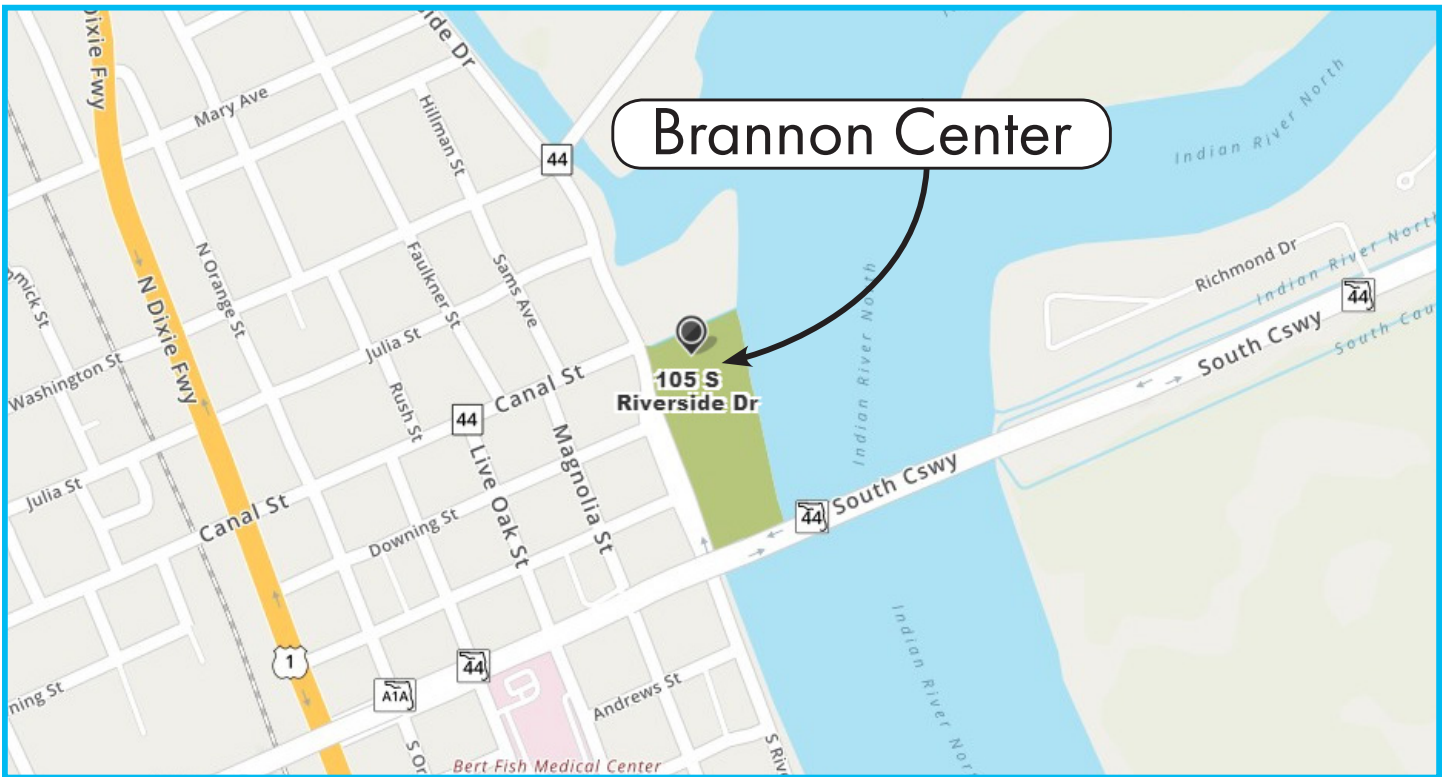
