




Tomoka River Bridge Improvements




Existing Bridge

Proposed Bridge



- 340-feet long
- Three 11-foot travel lanes in each direction
- Left-turn lanes
- 12-foot shared use paths on both sides
- Two wildlife paths to enhance wildlife connectivity


Existing Conditions - Access Class 4 (Non Restrictive Median Type)
