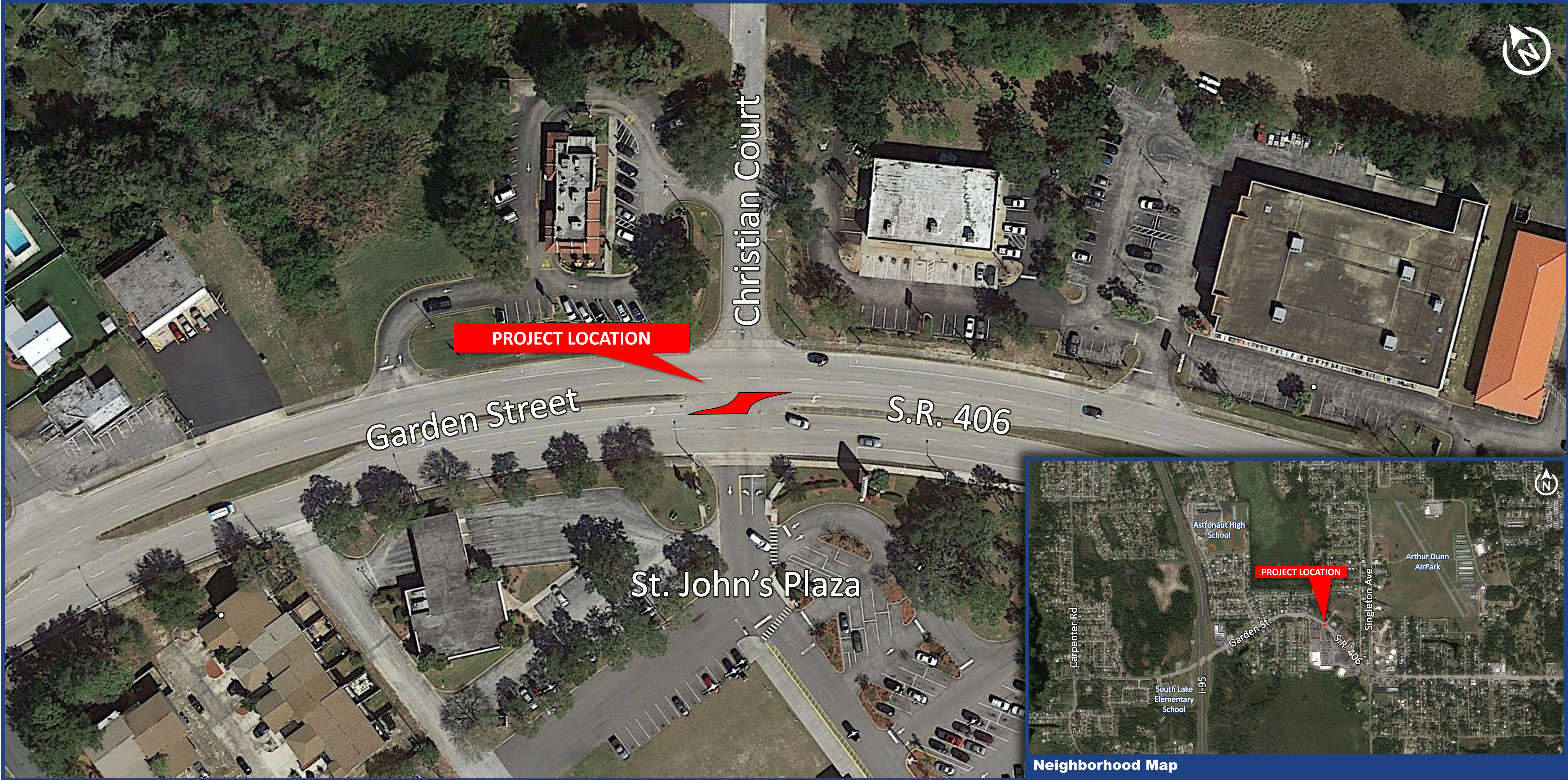

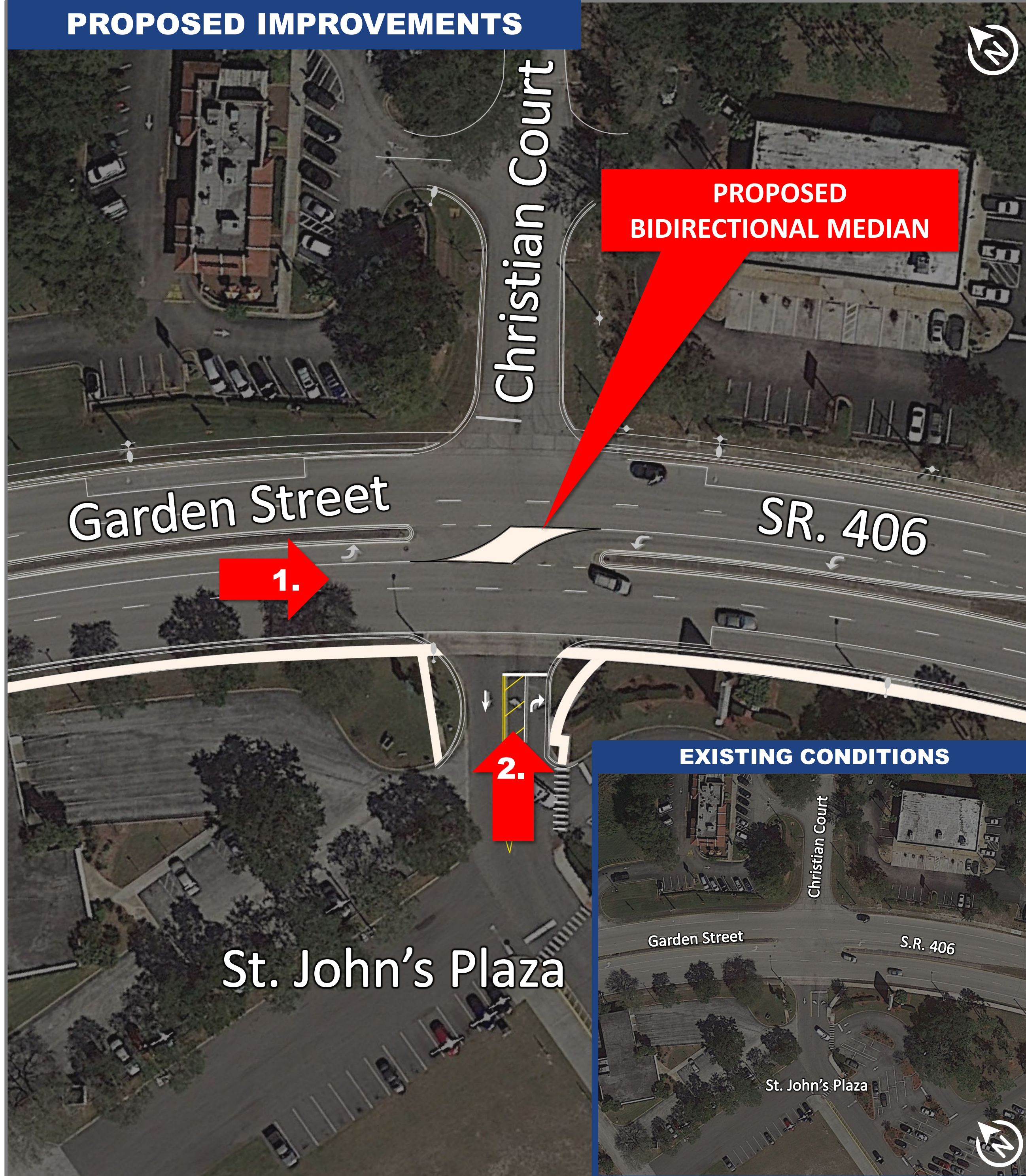

## Northbound at Christian Court

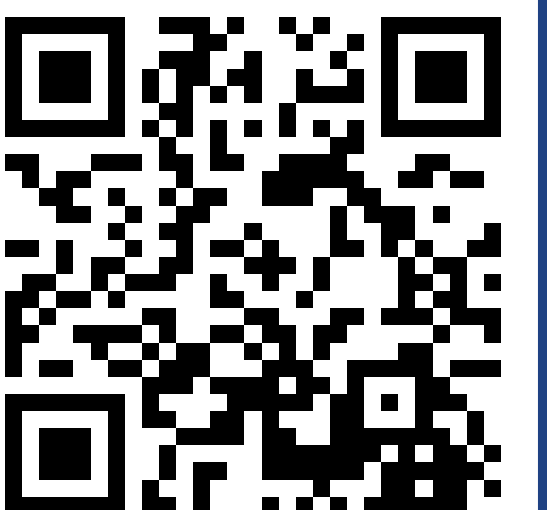

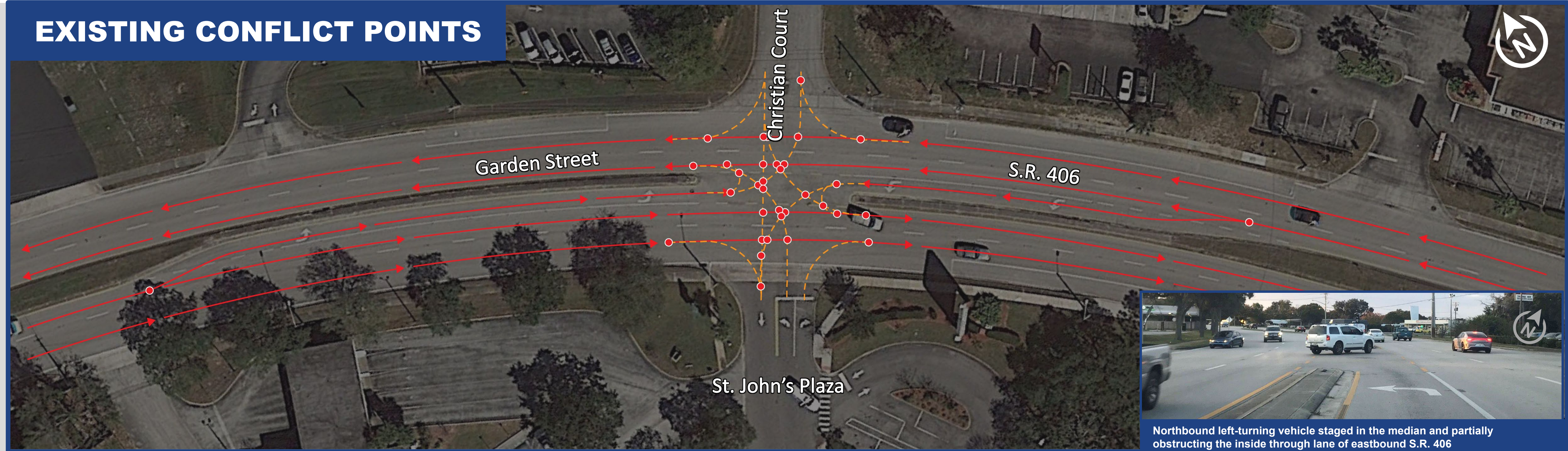
# Conflict Points

Conflict points are locations along a roadway where two vehicles could cross and potentially collide.

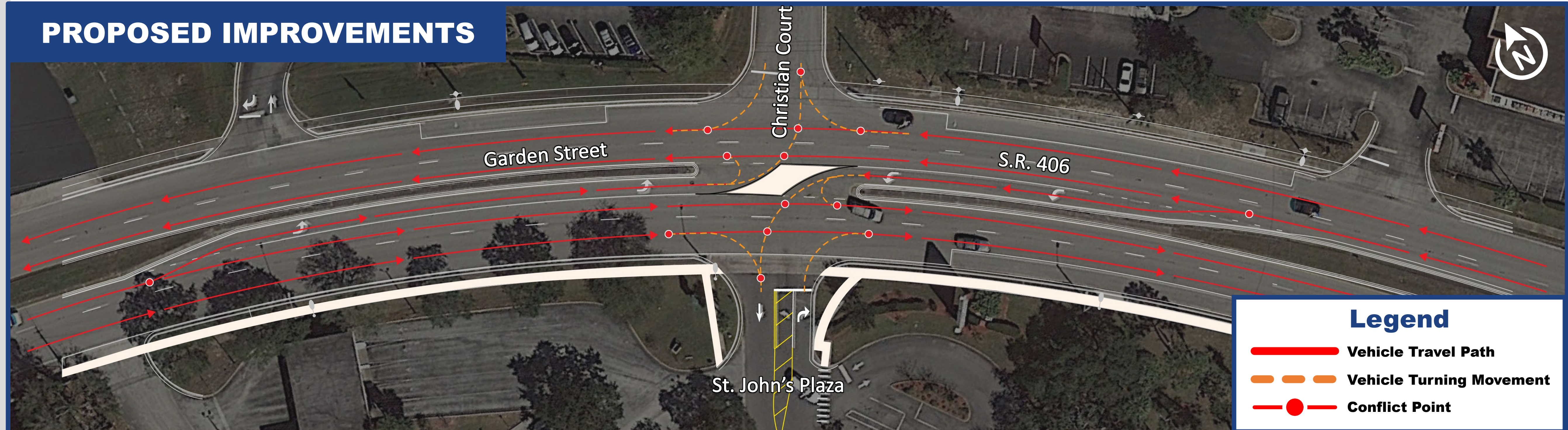
Currently, there is a full median opening at the intersection of Garden Street (S.R. 406) and Christian Court. Drivers staged in the median intending to turn northbound or southbound cannot clearly see approaching eastbound or westbound vehicles on Garden Street. While waiting to turn, drivers can block the inside through lane of Garden Street. Westbound left-turning drivers can obstruct the sight of traffic for northbound left-turning drivers who are staged in the median opening.

The proposed improvements aim to reduce these points of conflict and obstruction.
