

# SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

Woodland Boulevard (U.S. 17-92) from East Beresford Avenue to Plymouth Avenue

**Volusia County**

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is implementing pedestrian safety improvements along Woodland Boulevard (U.S. 17-92) from East Beresford Avenue to Plymouth Avenue in DeLand by upgrading two existing pedestrian crossings and adding six new pedestrian crossings at the following locations:

- Winnemissett Avenue
- The Intermodal Transportation Facility north of Euclid Avenue
- Georgia Avenue
- North of Michigan Avenue
- University Avenue
- South of Pennsylvania Avenue

Both the new and existing crosswalks will be equipped with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs), enhanced pavement markings, and pedestrian signage. Each RRFB will include flashing yellow LED lights to increase drivers' awareness of people crossing Woodland Boulevard. The beacons will remain dark until a pedestrian wishing to cross the roadway pushes a button to activate the flashing lights. Improvements will also include pedestrian curb ramp installation and sidewalk repair.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect intermittent daytime and nighttime lane closures on Woodland Boulevard. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic around closures. Intermittent sidewalk detours will be utilized to accommodate pedestrian traffic around the work area. Access to side streets, residences, and businesses will be maintained throughout the duration of the project.

The level of work activity will vary during different phases of construction, and the schedule may change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances. 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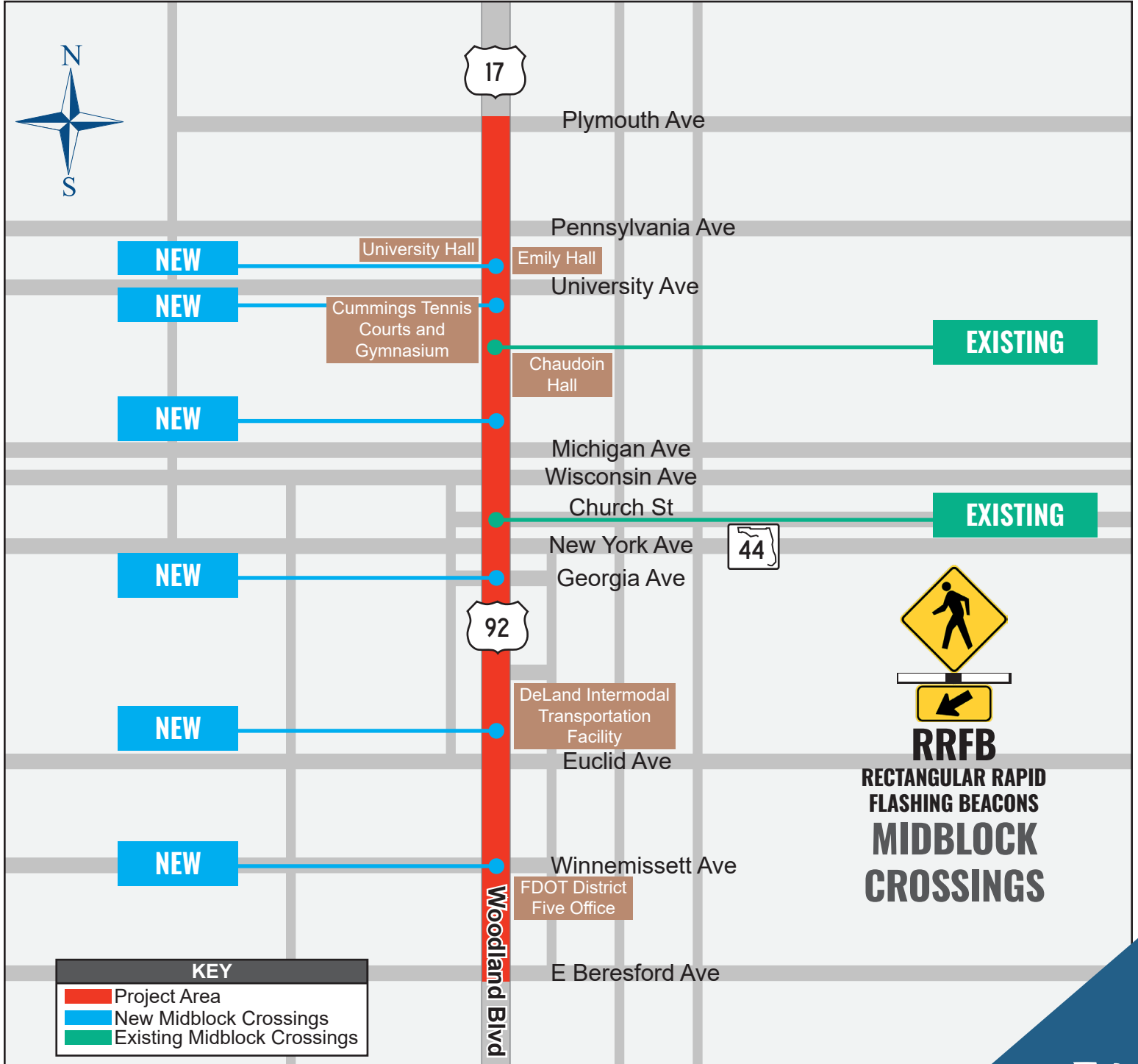
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
