



North Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 441) Resurfacing from Wadsworth Road to the Lake County Line Orange County

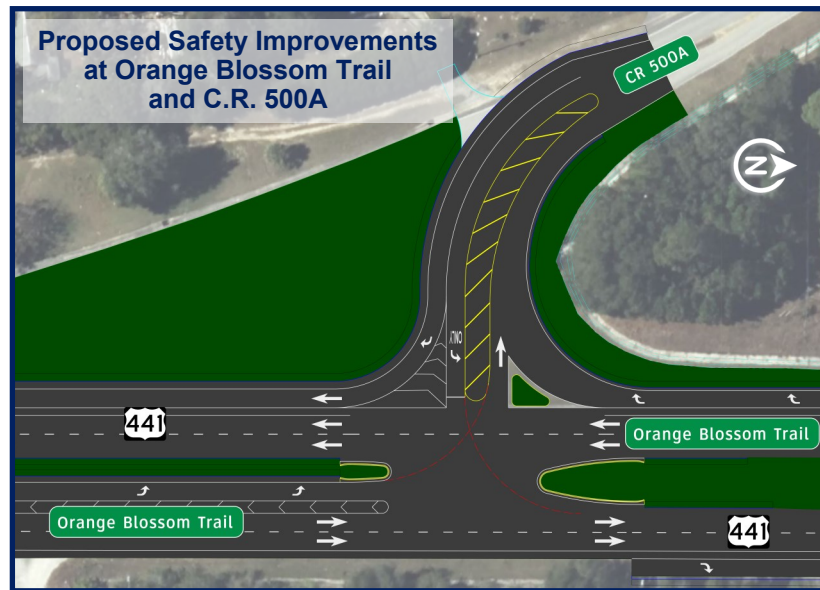


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning operational and safety improvements along North Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 441) from Wadsworth Road to the Lake County Line, between the cities of Apopka and Mount Dora. The goal of the project is to resurface this portion of North Orange Blossom Trail to extend the life of the existing roadway and increase safety along the project corridor.

FDOT is providing safety improvements at the intersection of North Orange Blossom Trail and County Road (C.R.) 500A, also known as Old Highway 441. The skew in the intersection will be eliminated by aligning C.R. 500A to a 90 degree angle with North Orange Blossom Trail. The updated configuration will slow down northbound left turning vehicles, provide better sight distance, and eliminate right of way confusion between left turning lanes.

Planned bicycle safety measures include construction of bicycle keyholes at right turns throughout the corridor. Pedestrian safety enhancements include high-emphasis crosswalk markings, crosswalk lighting, pedestrian refuges, and new pedestrian signals at Stonybrook Hills Parkway. Sidewalk connections are also proposed from LakeXpress bus stops on North Orange Blossom Trail to the shared use path on Stonybrook Hills Parkway.
