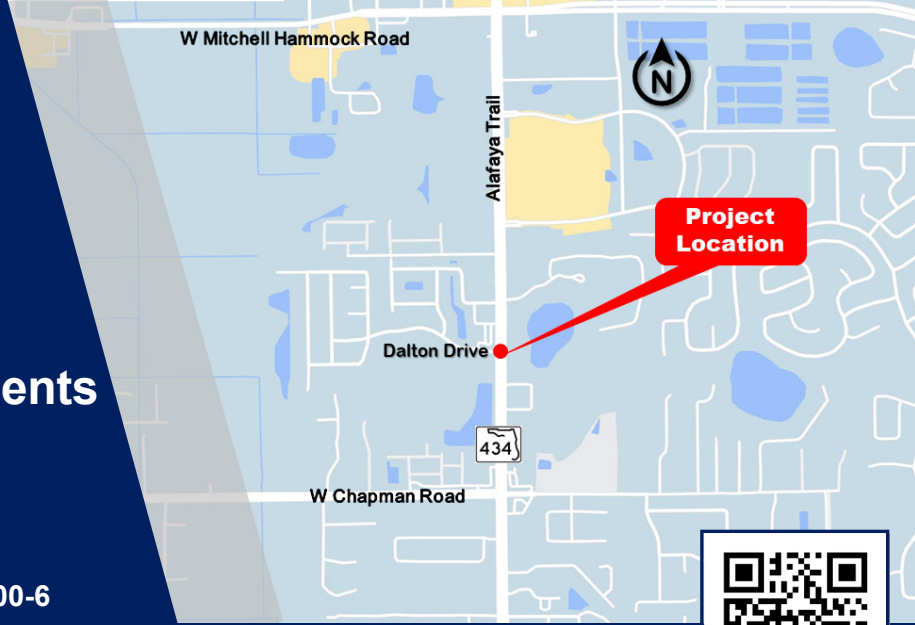




Alafaya Trail (S.R. 434) at Dalton Drive Safety Improvements

Seminole County

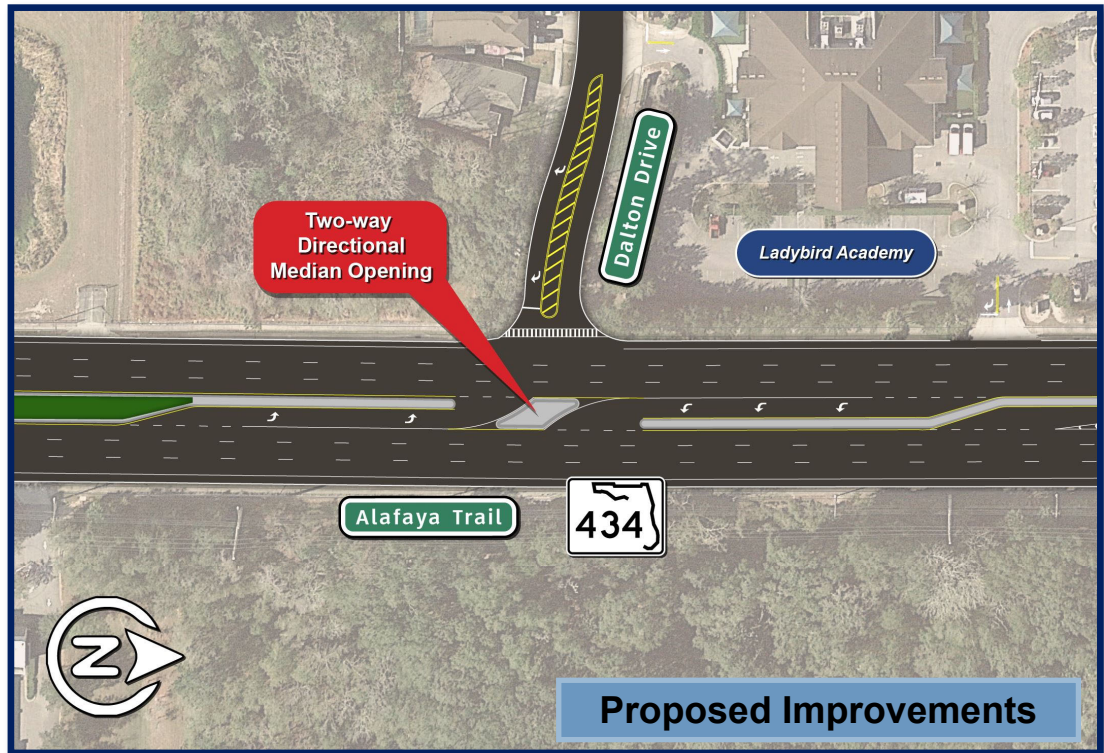

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing safety improvements at the intersection of Alafaya Trail (State Road (S.R.) 434) and Dalton Drive in Oviedo, Seminole County. These improvements will enhance safety by implementing improved access control, enhancing traffic flow and reducing the possibility of crashes.

Proposed improvements consist of converting the existing full median opening to a two-way directional median opening with the appropriate signage and pavement markings. These proposed improvements will continue to allow U-turns for both northbound and southbound traffic on Alafaya Trail (S.R. 434). Northbound traffic will also be able to turn left onto Dalton Drive. Right turns will only be possible from Dalton Drive onto Alafaya Trail (S.R. 434). New pavement markings and signage will be installed to direct drivers.
