State Road 40 Widening Projects, Marion County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding plans to widen three sections of State Road (S.R.) east of Ocala on Thursday, February 23, at 5:30 p.m. The three projects are (410674-2) S.R. 40 from the end of the four-lane section (just east of NE 58th Avenue) to east of County Road (C.R.) 314; (410674-3) S.R. 40 from east of C.R. 314 to east of C.R. 314A; (410674-4) S.R. 40 from east of C.R. 314A to SE 183rd Avenue Road (Levy Hammock Road). The purpose of all three projects is to enhance safety, increase capacity and provide multi-modal accommodations. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the live meeting.
