
Median Reconstruction for Pedestrian Crossings




Pedestrian Lighting Upgrades






Repaving: Improved Intersections for Motorists Current Conditions










U.S. 17-92 at Pleasant Hill Road Intersection Improvements















New Road Goals


- Improve operations and safety at the U.S. 17-92 and Pleasant Hill Road intersection
- Implement fiscally responsible solutions and advance short-term solutions
- Maintain adjacent business access and site circulation
- Improve access and travel direction opportunities for The Oaks neighborhood residents
- Provide multimodal access consistent with corridor context






Right of Way Requirements


- Right of way acquisition is needed
- No Relocations are anticipated
- Department representatives will contact affected owners directly
- All acquisitions will follow the federal Uniform Relocation Act and FDOT Real Estate Acquisition Process















How will the New Road enhance the quality of the roadway and improve intersection effectiveness?

By relocating 80% of the existing northbound-to eastbound and westbound-to-southbound movements from the JYP and Pleasant Hill Road intersection to the new roadway it simplifies the main intersection, allowing for shorter light cycles.








Multimodal Access: Osceola Trail Network


New Road Shared Use Paths






