### **Westbound Traffic Shift on I-4 Near Daytona Beach**

**Volusia County**— Drivers need to be aware of an upcoming westbound lane shift on I-4 near Daytona Beach, next week. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and its contractor, The de Moya Group, are planning the nighttime lane shift on I-4 between the US-92 ramp and State Road (SR) 44 on December 2, 2014 (Tuesday).

This shift is related to the current FDOT widening project already underway in the area, and will involve shifting westbound traffic from the temporary roadway to the newly constructed roadway.

Times and dates could change based on weather conditions and other variables, and updates will be provided if the schedule is modified.
