Detour scheduled for eastbound Interstate 4 near Daytona Beach

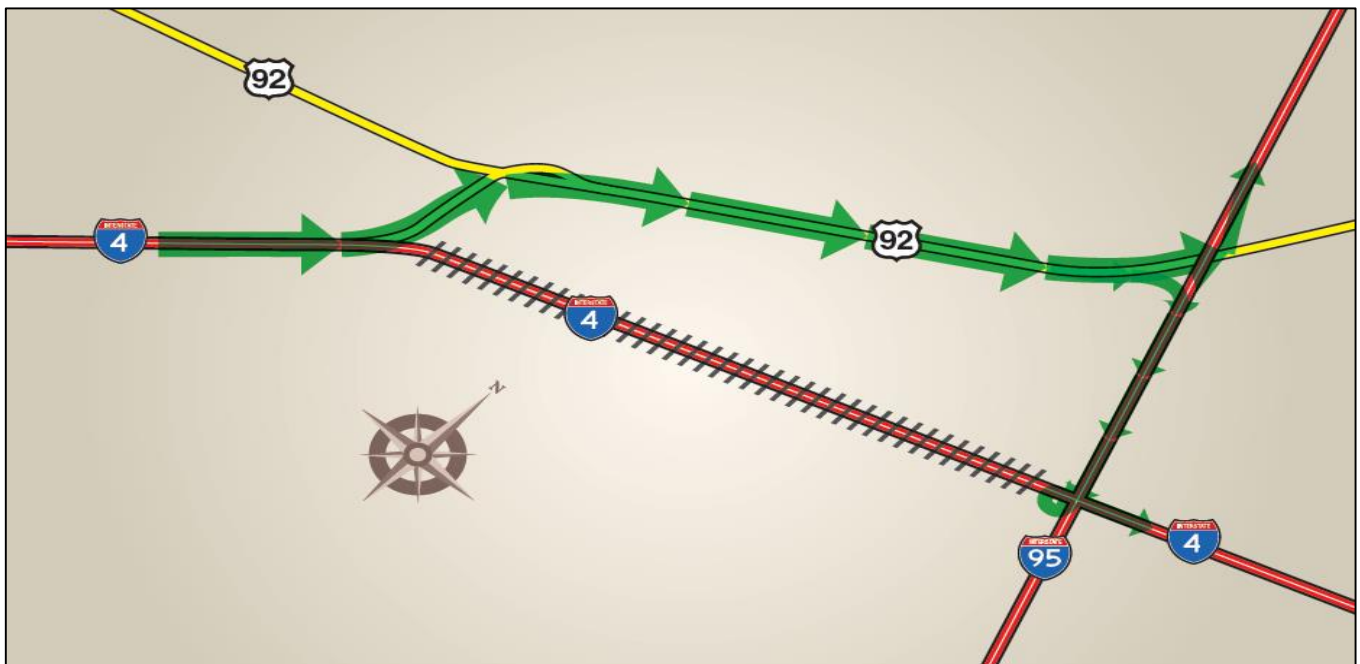
Volusia County – There will be an eastbound road closure on Interstate 4 (I-4) near Daytona Beach for construction related to the ongoing widening project. To accommodate the work, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and its contractor, The de Moya Group, scheduled overnight detours 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Thursday, May 7.

The I-4 eastbound lanes will be closed. The detour will route traffic onto US 92 east to I-95. Drivers can travel southbound on I-95 to reconnect with I-4.

Times and dates could change based on weather conditions and other variables, updates will be provided if the schedule is modified.
