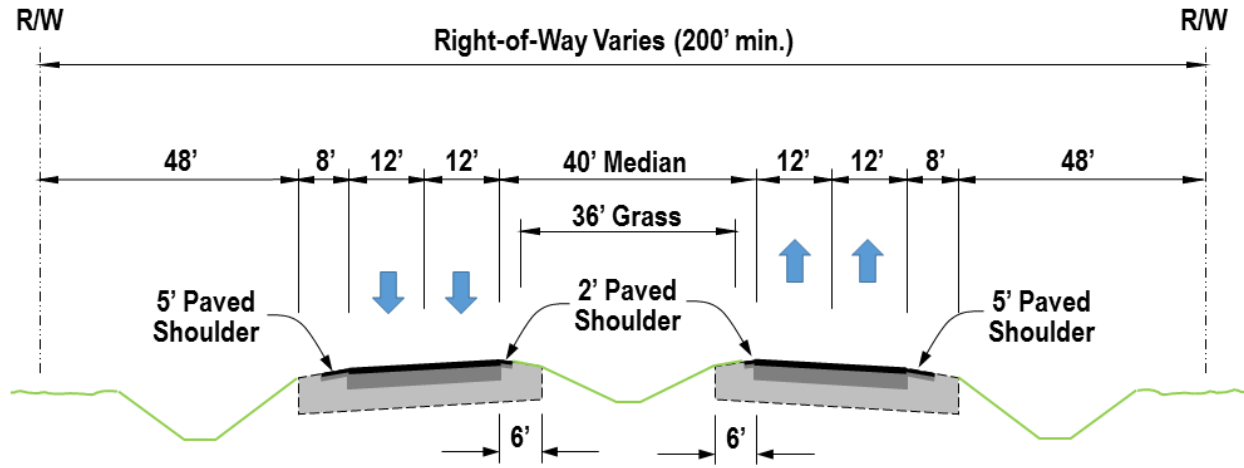
Project Facts

The project limits are on State Road (SR) 200 from north of the Citrus County Line to south of County Road (CR) 484. The Florida Department of Transportation is proposing to widen the existing two lane roadway to a four lane divided roadway with a 40' grass median. Additionally, there will be 4 grade level bridges on the project: two for wildlife crossings, one for a pedestrian trail crossing, and one equestrian crossing. All crossings will be under the roadway. A 16' wildlife fence will be constructed on FDOT Right-of-Way on portions of the corridor.

Status: Under design, scheduled to be complete in early 2017. Project is not yet funded for construction.

Proposed Widening

The proposed improvements include widening of the existing two lane roadway to four lanes, with the addition of a 40' grass median as shown on the typical section below. There are no new signals proposed for this project.

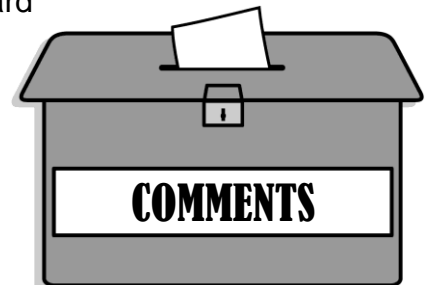
