

A public meeting is being held to describe and illustrate planned improvements on SR 414 (Maitland Boulevard) from east of Interstate 4 to east of County Road (CR) 427 (Maitland Avenue) in Maitland. The meeting will follow an open house format where you are able to review project documents and discuss the project with staff members. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) encourages your participation and welcomes your comments on this transportation improvement project.



This project includes the inside-widening of SR 414 (Maitland Boulevard) from the existing four-lane suburban facility to an urban six-lane facility for the limits noted above. The ultimate roadway will be primarily a divided urban six-lane roadway with three lanes in each direction separated by a raised median. Sidewalks will be continuous on both sides. Full signalized median openings will be maintained at both Maitland Avenue and Maitland Concourse. A new median opening will be constructed between Maitland Concourse and Maitland Avenue. The existing median opening at Lake Faith Villas will be converted to a directional opening.
