Welcome to the SR 436 Concept Development Study Public Meeting! The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting this meeting as a follow-up to the SR 436 Corridor Planning Study, where a number of alternatives were presented to accommodate pedestrians, bicyclists, transit users, and automobiles along the corridor.

As part of the Concept Development Study, the preferred alternative from the previous Corridor Planning Study was refined based on additional right-of-way, drainage, utility, landscaping, and traffic operations assessments. The purpose of this meeting is to present, discuss, and gather public input on the development of the preferred alternative.

## Next Steps

The next step in the study process is to refine the concept based on comments received and develop a design scope based on the SR 436 concept.
