

CONSTRUCTION ALERT



State Road (S.R.) 35 (Baseline Road) Southeast 96th Place Road to south of S.R. 464 (Southeast Maricamp Road)

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be closing Dogwood Road at State Road 35 (Baseline Road) for two nights during the week of April 1, most likely Wednesday and Thursday. The suggested detour is Dogwood Trail and Dogwood Trail Course (Trl Cse.) (see map below). Also, there will be no effect on accessing the businesses at the intersection.

The work is part of the FDOT's project to widen Baseline Road from Southeast 96th Place Road to south of S.R. 464 (Southeast Maricamp Road) from a two-lane to a four-lane roadway. Additional work includes sidewalks, drainage improvements, signing and pavement markings, guardrails, new signals, and driveways.

Safety

The speed limit within the construction zone is reduced to 45 mph. FDOT reminds all road users to pay attention, drive with care and always buckle up.

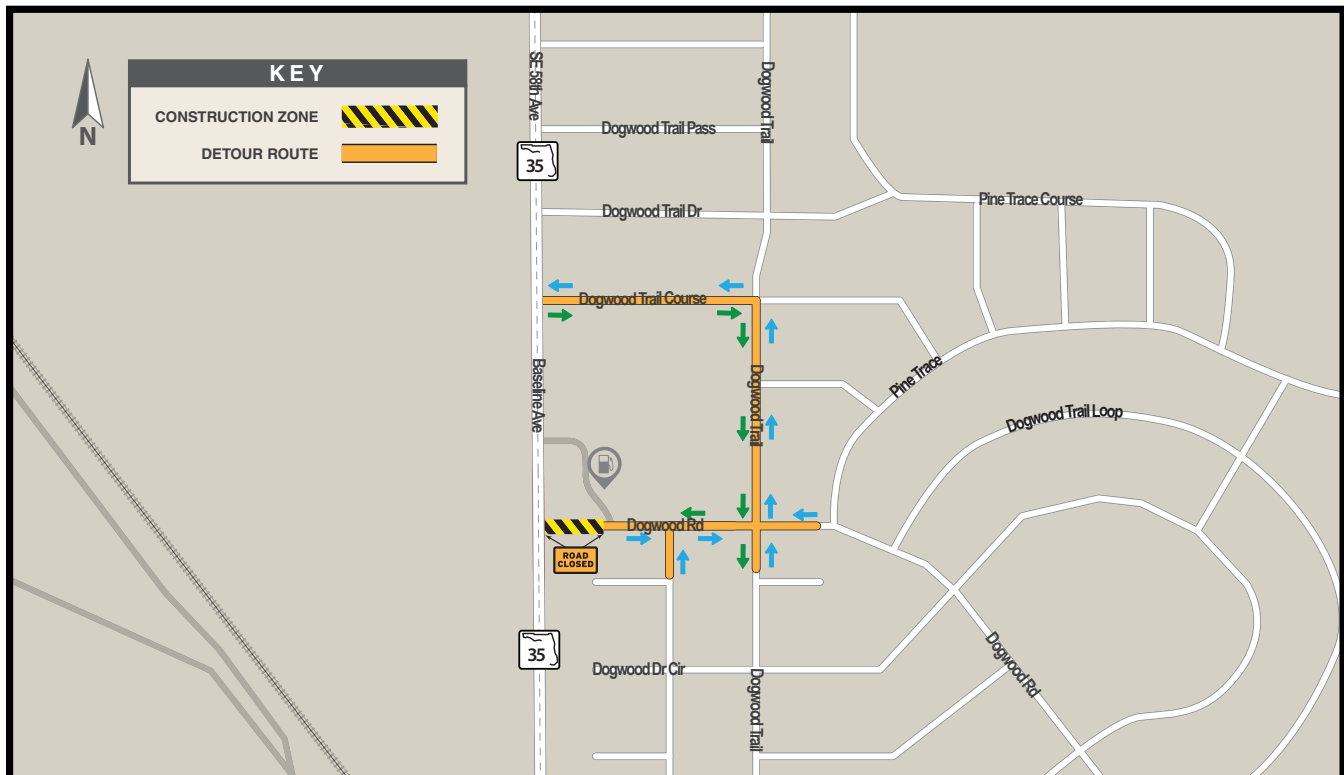
