Construction Alert

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be closing lanes on 66th Street for one week to reconstruct the roadway. The closures will begin on Monday, May 7, and continue through Saturday, May 12. The lane closures will alternate between eastbound and westbound, with only one lane closed at-a-time. Traffic will be able to travel eastbound and turn onto Baseline Road, but traffic needing to enter 66th Street (heading westbound) will be directed to use the following posted detour: Juniper Road, just south of 66th Street, to Laurel Pass, north to 66th Street. Detour signs will be posted. Please note that construction schedules can change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

The work is part of the FDOT's project to widen Baseline Road from Southeast 96th Place Road to south of S.R. 464 (Southeast Maricamp Road) from a two-lane to a four-lane roadway. Additional work includes sidewalks, drainage improvements, signing and pavement markings, guardrails, new signals, and driveways.

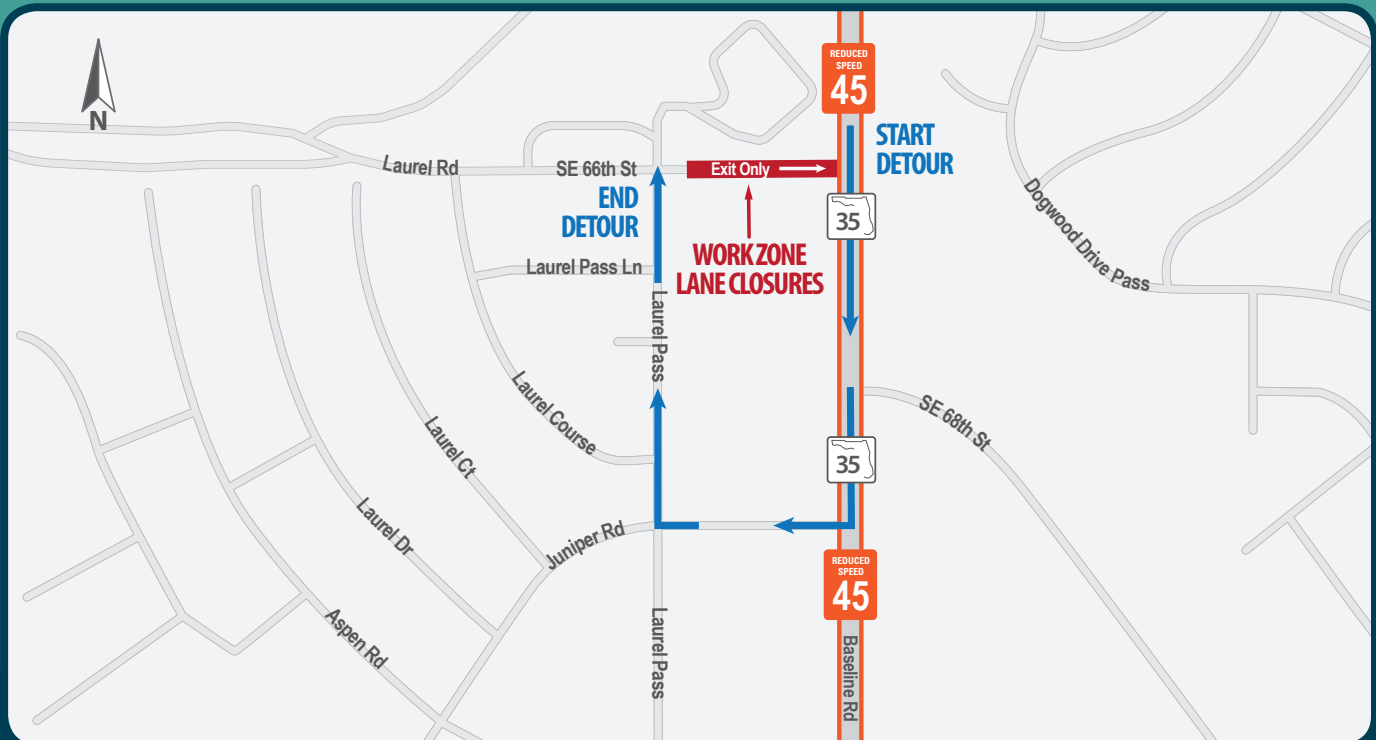
