WELCOME

Welcome to the kickoff meeting for the Interstate 95 (I-95) at Pioneer Trail Interchange Project Development & Environment (PD&E) study. This informal, open house public meeting is being conducted to provide an opportunity for you to learn about the project, become familiar with the study process and provide initial feedback. Informational handouts and display boards are available for review. FDOT and project team members will be available to discuss the project and answer questions. There will be no formal presentation.

The objective of the study is to evaluate roadway and interchange alternatives associated with a new interchange at I-95 and Pioneer Trail. The study will analyze and assess the proposed project's impact on the social, economic, cultural, natural, and physical environment, in order to develop the location and design concept in accordance with FDOT policy, procedures and requirements.

PROJECT PURPOSE & NEED

The purpose of the proposed interchange at I-95 and Pioneer Trail is to relieve traffic congestion on the two interchanges north and south of the project: I-95 at State Road 421/Dunlawton Avenue and I-95 at State Road 44/Lytle Avenue. The project also aims to support economic development associated with existing and approved developments, including three developments of regional impact.

WHAT IS A PD&E STUDY

A PD&E study is the process conducted by FDOT to determine the social, economic and environmental impacts associated with proposed transportation improvements. The process, mandated by the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), provides the necessary environmental studies, preliminary engineering and related services to analyze and develop the best project alternative for the community’s transportation needs while minimizing potential environmental impacts.

The PD&E Study process begins with data collection followed by engineering analysis and environmental evaluations.

We are currently at the public kick-off meeting stage introducing the project to the public and asking for local input. Public involvement is ongoing throughout the study.
