Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is making roadway improvements to Garden Street in the City of Titusville. In conjunction with this project is the construction of a half-mile, 12-foot wide, multi-use trail that will be a part of the East Coast Rail Trail system. Various pedestrian improvements will also be added to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act standards. These improvements will also include:

- Milling, resurfacing and the addition of bicycle lanes
- Curb, gutter and sidewalk improvements
- Pedestrian and traffic signal upgrades
- Pedestrian ramps and traffic separators
