NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT (NEPA)

A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) assignment was executed on December 14, 2016. The FDOT now has the assignment of NEPA responsibilities as described in the MOU and the requirements are in effect.

FDOT shall disclose to the public and agencies, as part of agency outreach and public involvement procedures, including any Notice of Intent or scoping meeting notice, the statement below:

“The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) pursuant to 23 U.S.C. §327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 14, 2016 and executed by the Federal Highway Administration and FDOT.”
