



# State Road 44 from West of County Road (C.R.) 437 to West of C.R. 42

## Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing State Road 44 from west of County Road 437 in Sorrento to west of the Volusia County line. Additional activities include sign and pavement marking improvements, traffic signal work, and right turn lane extensions in specific locations.

Please note some mailbox posts located along the corridor will be changed, and some community mailboxes will be moved so they are not within the clear zone. The clear zone is an area that provides space for a driver to stop safely, or regain control of a vehicle that has left the road.

## Lane Closures:

Drivers can expect single lane closures with flagging between 7:30 p.m. and 7 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.

Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to inform motorists about upcoming closures or any other significant traffic pattern changes. Access to businesses and/or residences will be maintained.

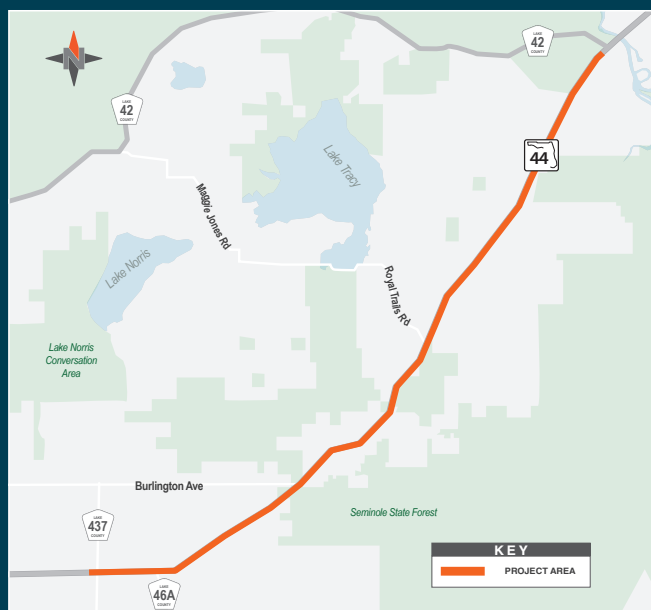
FDOT urges all drivers to stay alert and use caution while driving through or near construction zones.
