OPEN HOUSE SCHEDULED

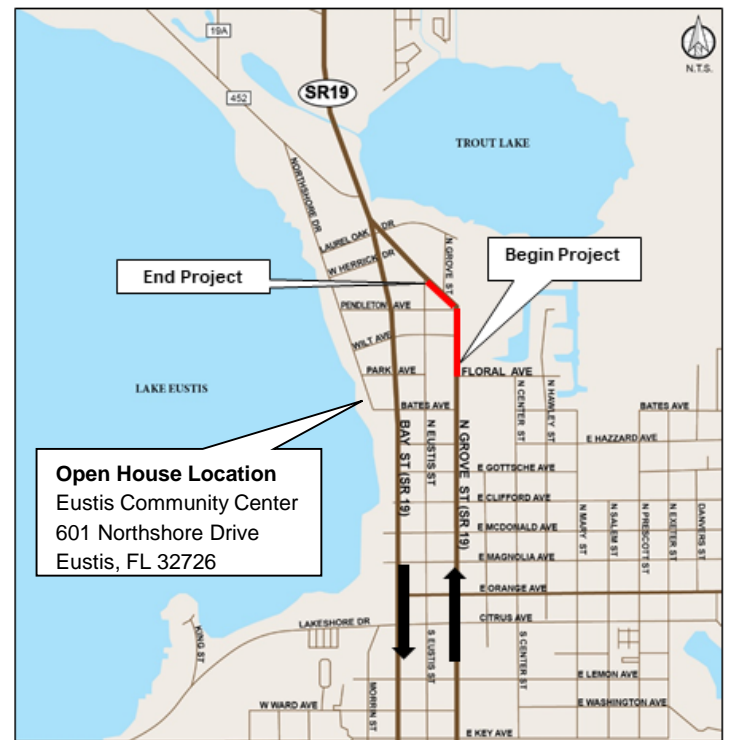
The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is holding an open house to present information about the safety improvements to the curve along North Grove Street (State Road 19). The open house will be from **5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Thursday, September 26, 2019, at the Eustis Community Center, 601 Northshore Drive in downtown Eustis.** (See the map to the right for location.)

Project information will be available for review and individuals may hold one-on-one conversations with the FDOT project team. A project presentation will run on a continuous loop and may be viewed during the open house. Project Description

The project is located within the City of Eustis in Lake County. The project limits are along North Grove Street (the northbound segment of State Road 19) from East Floral Avenue to North Eustis Street. The intent of this project is to enhance safety by realigning the curve along the project limits within the existing right of way.
