PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be resurfacing U.S. 192/U.S. 441 (East Irló Bronson Memorial Highway) from west of Arthur J. Gallagher Boulevard to east of Harmony Square Drive in Harmony.

Additional improvements include new signing and pavement marking, drainage upgrades, and signal work. Pedestrian features such as curb ramps, pedestrian signals, a crosswalk, and a bicycle lane between the through lane and right turn lane will be added to the south end of the intersection at Arthur J. Gallagher Boulevard. These pedestrian improvements will comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect both daytime and nighttime lane closures. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert traffic to upcoming closures. Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.

Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with resurfacing projects as the contractor must put down different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Motorists are asked to use extra caution while driving through the work zone. Road conditions during construction are temporary and will become less apparent as the project progresses.

Additionally, the level of work activity will vary during different phases of construction, and paving operations will be intermittent.


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
