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State Road 464 Over CSX Railroad Improvement Project

Ocala, FL- The Florida Department of Transportation began an Improvement Project on State Road 464 over the CSX Transportation railroad from 12th Avenue to US 441/US 27/US 301 (Pine Avenue) on October 15, 2007. The initial construction phase of this project will begin December 9, 2007. This project involves constructing a four-lane, two-way overpass on SR 464 (SW 17th Street) over the CSX Transportation railroad and two-lane, two-way service roads on SR 464 to provide access to adjacent development. The project shall extend from approximately 800 feet west of the intersection of SR 464 with SW 12th Avenue east to the west side of the intersection of SR 464 with US 441/US 301/ US27 (Pine Avenue).

Other work associated with this \$24.5 million project will include construction of a new right-turn lane for eastbound US 301/US 441/ US 27, a temporary crossing of the CSX railroad, bridge construction, new sidewalk, drainage system improvements, new traffic signals and signage, and milling and resurfacing. These enhancements will provide an improved measure of safety to this heavily traveled corridor.

The work, to be performed by Kiewit Southern Co., crews and their subcontractors will last approximately 650 calendar days, weather permitting.

Lane closures will be necessary at various times and locations in order for workers to complete this work safely.

Please use extreme caution and be alert when driving, walking or biking around the construction area. Motorists should be alert for lane shifts or closures, and for construction equipment entering and leaving the highway.

Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes, to avoid travel time delays.

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
