

U.S. 441 at Lake Park Court Median Improvements

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements at the intersection of U.S. 441 (State Road (S.R.) 500/ S.R. 44) and Lake Park Court in Lake County. These improvements will enhance safety by implementing improved access control, enhancing traffic flow and reducing conflict points, or locations where a crash can occur.

Proposed improvements consist of converting the existing full median opening to a westbound directional median opening. These proposed changes to the median will allow U-turns and left

turns onto Lake Park Court for westbound traffic on U.S. 441. With these proposed changes only right turns will be possible from Lake Park Court onto eastbound U.S. 441.

Signage and pavement markings will also be updated.
