#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will resurface all travel lanes along Interstate 4 (I-4) (State Road (S.R.) 400) from west of County Road (C.R.) 4139 (Cassadaga Road) to east of S.R. 44.

This project will also include pavement widening, new highway signs, roadway markings, and Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) components to enhance safety, mobility, and efficiency for all road users.

Additionally, this project will reconstruct the sidewalk and pedestrian curb ramps at the Orange Camp Road (Exit 116) and S.R. 44 (Exit 118) interchanges. A signalized pedestrian crosswalk will be installed at the I-4 ramp onto westbound S.R. 44 to improve pedestrian safety and mobility.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect intermittent nighttime lane closures. The contractor will maintain pedestrian access to sidewalks during construction using signed detours, traffic control devices, and/or temporary walkways and ramps, when appropriate.
