




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PROJECT LOCATION






PURPOSE AND NEED

- Modify existing drainage ditch from US 1 to Indian River
- Eliminate existing siltation in headwall at Indian River
- Provide regional pond associated with SR 528 improvements
- Restore historic drainage flow across railroads near US 1 and SR 528



PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS (Drainage Outfall Ditch)






PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS (Drainage Outfall Ditch)

Project Benefits Include

- Regional Pond: Capture rainfall runoff and improve water quality prior to outfall to Indian River
- Regional Pond: Reduce likelihood of flooding at Indian River Drive
- Regional Pond: Offset SR 528 pond needs, reduce right of way impact along SR 528
- Outfall Ditch: Ease of maintenance with using underground pipes
- Outfall Ditch: Elimination of headwall siltation
- Outfall Ditch: Reduce side slope erosion adjacent to property lines

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








PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS (SR 528 & US 1 Interchange)
