INTERSECTION UPGRADES AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

S.R. 5054 (Sarno Road) at Wickham Road Mast Arm Upgrades

Brevard County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will improve safety and traffic operations on State Road (S.R.) 5054 (Sarno Road) at the Wickham Road intersection. FDOT aims to extend the service life of the roadway by upgrading the existing traffic signals with mast arms. This intersection rehabilitation project will include milling and resurfacing of the intersection, ADA upgrades and improvements, and sidewalk restoration. This project will improve roadway conditions for motorists, help enhance safety in the area, and ensure roadway signal visibility.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect nighttime lane closures throughout construction. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of traffic changes. Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with projects that require resurfacing as the contractor must place different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Road conditions during construction will become less apparent as the project progresses. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone.
