# **INTERSECTION RESURFACING AND IMPROVEMENTS**

North Courtenay Parkway (S.R. 3) at Mustang Way Intersection

## **Brevard County**

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be improving safety and traffic operations on North Courtenay Parkway (State Road (S.R.) 3) at the Lucas Road/Mustang Way Intersection. FDOT aims to extend the service life of the roadway by resurfacing the intersection on North Courtenay Parkway (S.R. 3) in Brevard County. This resurfacing and rehabilitation project will include updating mast arms, pedestrian curbs, and pavement markings along the roadway. This project will improve roadway conditions for motorists, help enhance accessibility in the area, and ensure roadway longevity.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect lane closures throughout construction. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of traffic changes. Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with projects that require resurfacing, as the contractor must place different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Road conditions during construction will become less apparent as the project progresses. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone.


