PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing State Road 44 in Sumter County from just west of Interstate 75 to the Citrus County line. The work will also include stormwater pipe repairs and shoulder widening in some locations.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists can expect frequent single-lane closures during daytime hours. Signage and traffic control devices will direct drivers through the remaining open lanes during these closures. Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with resurfacing projects as the contractor must put down different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Road conditions during construction are short-term and will become less apparent as the project progresses. Motorists are asked to exercise caution while driving through the work zone.


