

## State Road (S.R.) 60 Widening & U.S. 441 Resurfacing **Drive-Thru Open House**

Financial Project Identification Nos.: 441036-1 and 439487-1

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing to widen State Road (S.R.) 60 to accommodate two 12-foot-wide travel lanes and a 12-foot-wide center turn lane from west of U.S. 441 to east of the Florida's Turnpike in Yeehaw Junction, Osceola County.

## **Meeting Location:**

**Outside the Desert Inn** 5570 S. Kenansville Road Yeehaw Junction, FL 34972 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. The new center turn lane will help to alleviate congestion and improve operations between the Florida's Turnpike on and off ramps, and the U.S. 441 intersection. The improvements also include 5-foot-wide paved outside shoulders, drainage, signal, and Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) improvements.

Additionally, the department is designing a project to resurface all travel lanes of U.S. 441 from the Osceola/Okeechobee County line to S.R. 60. The project also will include minor safety enhancements and drainage improvements.

The community is invited to learn more about both projects by attending a drive-thru open house on Tuesday, Oct. 15, on the property of the historic Desert Inn at the intersection of S.R. 60 and U.S. 441. Attendees may stop by the project any time between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. to view project exhibits, speak with project team members and provide input.

The community may also view project information and provide input through the project's webpage at www.cflroads.com (*search 441036-1*). Information shared at the open house will be posted on the website within two working days of the meeting.
