PUBLIC NOTIFICATION


The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is designing improvements to U.S. 301/U.S. 441 (State Road (S.R.) 25) in Marion County. The purpose of this project is to increase traffic efficiency and enhance safety on the corridor between NW 20th Street and the U.S. 301/U.S. 441 interchange.

The proposed improvements include access management median modifications from NW 20th Street to S.R. 326 by converting the full median openings to bi-directional medians in some locations and closing median openings in other locations. These improvements will help reduce the number of conflict points for motorists, which increases safety and also helps to enhance the traffic flow in the area.

Additional improvements include roadway resurfacing from NW 20th Street to the U.S. 301/U.S. 441 interchange. This project will mill and resurface pavement, add and extend some left turn lanes, and add bicycle through lanes at some intersections.

A public hearing will be held at a future date to present information and obtain public input regarding the proposed designs. In the meantime, we welcome your questions and comments.
