## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing State Road 44 in Leesburg from Bottle Brush Court to U.S. 27 (Northwest 14th Street), a distance of about 1.1 miles. The work will include sidewalk replacement in some places and curb ramp improvements to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act requirements.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists can expect frequent single-lane closures during nighttime hours. Signage and traffic control devices will direct drivers through the remaining open lanes during these closures. Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with resurfacing projects as the contractor must put down different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Rough road conditions during construction are short-term and will become less apparent as the project progresses. Motorists are asked to exercise caution while driving through the work zone.
