

SE 17th Street/Maricamp Road Resurfacing From east of U.S. 301/U.S. 27 to S.R. 35

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is designing roadway improvements along nearly 6 miles of SE 17th Street/Maricamp Road (State Road (S.R.) 464) from east of U.S. 301/U.S. 27 to S.R. 35. The goal of the project is to rehabilitate the roadway and enhance safety for drivers, bicyclists and pedestrians.

The project will extend the life of the existing roadway by repaving this segment of S.R. 464. Restriping to provide bicycle lanes along portions of the corridor will help to enhance safety for bicyclists. The project will also construct segments of sidewalk to fill in gaps and reconstruct sidewalk curb ramps at intersections in accordance with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Other pedestrian safety measures include realigning crosswalks, upgrading the pedestrian signals, and enhancing intersection lighting. Additionally, plans call for modifying some driveways and adjusting drainage as needed to help operations along the corridor.
