


## N. Orange Blossom Trail at Rosamond Drive Orange County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites you to attend an open house about plans to install a new traffic signal at the intersection of North Orange Blossom Trail (State Road 500/U.S. 441) and Rosamond Drive in Orlando.

The open house will be held on *Thursday, November* 7, 2019, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Rosemont Neighborhood Center located at 4872 Rose Bay Drive, Orlando. You may come any time during those hours to review project displays and to hold one-on-one conversations with the FDOT project team. There will be no project presentation.

The project is located within the City of Orlando and adjacent to unincorporated Orange County. The purpose of this project is to signalize the intersection of North Orange Blossom Trail and Rosamond Drive. This safety project also includes improving the intersection's traffic operations and installing pedestrian ramps, lighting, signal and crosswalks. Construction is expected to begin by summer 2023 at an estimated cost of \$756,548.
