S.R. 500/U.S. 192 Milling and Resurfacing from Osceola County Line to Brandywine Lane/Columbia Lane

Brevard County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will improve safety and traffic operations on State Road (S.R.) 500/ United States (U.S.) 192. FDOT aims to extend the service life of the roadway by resurfacing along S.R. 500/U.S. 192 from Osceola County Line to Brandywine Lane/Columbia Lane in Brevard County. This resurfacing and rehabilitation project will include updating median crossovers and pavement markings along the roadway. This project will also improve roadway conditions for motorists, help enhance drivability in the area, and ensure roadway longevity.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect daytime and nighttime lane closures throughout construction. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of traffic changes. Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with projects that require resurfacing, as the contractor must place different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Road conditions during construction will become less apparent as the project progresses. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone.


