ROADWAY AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS

S.R. 520 from Aurora Street to Hubert Humphrey Causeway

Brevard County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be improving safety and traffic operations on State Road (S.R.) 520 in the City of Cocoa, from Aurora Street to Hubert Humphrey Causeway. S.R. 520 splits east of U.S. 1, with eastbound traffic on King Street and westbound traffic on Willard Street. FDOT aims to improve access and mobility throughout the project limits by repaying the roadway, widening bicycle lanes where possible and removing the auxiliary lane to accommodate a new 7-foot-wide parking lane on eastbound S.R. 520/ King Street east of U.S. 1.

This project also includes pedestrian enhancements consisting of reconstructing and extending curbs to shorten pedestrian crossing distance, improved crosswalks, and upgraded pedestrian signals. Additionally, a sidewalk will be constructed to close gaps and existing sidewalks and curb ramps will be updated to meet current Americans with Disabilities (ADA) standards. This project will improve roadway conditions for motorists, help enhance pedestrian visibility in the area, and improve accessibility along S.R. 520.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists should expect lane closures throughout construction. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of traffic changes. Uneven pavement is a common, unavoidable roadway condition with projects that require resurfacing, as the contractor must place different layers of asphalt during various phases of construction. Road conditions during construction will become less apparent as the project progresses. Pedestrian detours will be placed in areas where the sidewalk is inaccessible during construction. Motorists and pedestrians are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone.


