PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) project will provide safety and roadway improvements on State Road (S.R.) 44 from the Interstate 95 (I-95) interchange to Florida Memorial Parkway in New Smyrna Beach. The improvements include adding an eastbound auxiliary lane for motorists coming from the southbound I-95 exit ramp, adding a westbound deceleration lane for the northbound I-95 on ramp, and adding a second left turn lane from the northbound I-95 exit ramp to westbound S.R. 44. Additional work includes roadway resurfacing, drainage modifications, new signage and pavement markings, traffic signal upgrades, median modifications, and lighting improvements.

WHAT TO EXPECT

This project will require single lane closures and detours eastbound and westbound on S.R. 44. Lane closures will happen during daytime and nighttime hours, with detours occurring during overnight hours between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of closures.
