

## U.S. 1 Resurfacing from Brevard County Line to South Street

Design Began: December 2019

Initial Plans: July 2020

Final Plans: November 2020
Construction to begin: Fall 2021
Estimated Cost: \$8.1 million


## **Project Information**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is designing plans to resurface U.S. 1 from the Brevard County line to South Street in Volusia County. The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate about 6.7 miles of asphalt pavement through milling and resurfacing to extend the service life of the existing roadway. No changes to the typical section are proposed.

Necessary roadside improvements such as drainage upgrades, guardrail replacement, sidewalk reconstruction in certain areas, utility coordination, pedestrian/bicycle temporary traffic control plans and coordination with Votran regarding bus stop locations, landing pads and temporary construction are also included.
