




Project Purpose and Need


- Alleviate congestion and merging conflicts on John Young Parkway
- Physically separate the exit ramp traffic from traffic on John Young Parkway




The purpose of this safety project is to relieve congestion and merging conflicts by reducing weaving maneuvers involving traffic traveling south on John Young Parkway and traffic exiting westbound I-4. This will be accomplished by physically separating traffic coming from the westbound I-4 off ramp from traffic on southbound John Young Parkway heading to westbound LB McLeod Road.



The limits of this project are along John Young Parkway (County Road 423) from the westbound I-4 off ramp to LB McLeod Road in Orange County.




The proposed improvements are shown here in black and include a portion of the westbound I-4 off ramp and southbound John Young Parkway from north of the interchange to LB McLeod Road.



There are three typical sections along this project corridor.

The first typical section is on John Young Parkway from just north of the westbound I-4 off ramp to just north of LB McLeod Road.

The proposed typical section will provide a raised median that transitions to the new 7-foot-wide traffic separator between the two right turn lanes. The bike lane, the three through lanes and the left turn lane to eastbound LB McLeod Road will remain. The posted speed within this typical section will remain 45 mph.



The second typical section is the westbound I-4 off ramp that we will call Ramp 'A' which includes a portion of the ramp before the lanes split at the island.


This image represents the existing typical section. The project will restripe the lanes and add new pavement markings to guide proper navigation onto John Young Parkway and LB McLeod Road.

The advisory speed within this typical section is 35 miles per hour.



Typical Section 3 for Westbound I-4 Off-Ramp 'AA'

from the westbound I-4 off ramp 'A' to John Young Parkway



The third typical section is another area of the westbound I-4 off ramp that we will call ramp 'AA' connecting to John Young Parkway.

The proposed typical section will widen and reconstruct a curbed island to separate the free flow right turn lanes from the new dedicated right and left turn lanes at the signal. The advisory speed within this typical section is 35 miles per hour.



Other Proposed Improvements

- Mill and resurface southbound John Young Parkway and westbound I-4 off ramp
- Pavement widening and modification of the curbed island on John Young Parkway and LB McLeod Road
- Drainage improvements



Other roadway improvements included with this project include milling and resurfacing southbound lanes of John Young Parkway and westbound I-4 off ramp, pavement widening and modification of the curbed island on John Young Parkway and LB McLeod Road to accommodate large truck traffic turning right. Existing drainage patterns will be maintained, and new inlets will be added within the proposed pavement widening areas.





Pedestrian Upgrades

- Update curb ramps at impacted locations to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements
- Add pedestrian median on the north side of the John Young Parkway and LB McLeod Road Intersection

Proposed pedestrian upgrades include updating curb ramps at impacted locations to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards and adding a pedestrian median refuge on the north side of the John Young Parkway and LB McLeod Road Intersection.



Signing and Pavement Marking Upgrades

- Install new pavement markings throughout the project limits
- Upgrade existing signing to correspond with the proposed improvements
- Add wrong way driving signing and pavement markings at the westbound I-4 off ramp





Pavement markings will be refreshed throughout the project limits, and existing signing along the project corridor will be upgraded to correspond with the proposed improvements. Wrong way driving signing and pavement markings will be added at the westbound I-4 off ramp.



Lighting Upgrades

- Relocate light pole at the westbound I-4 off ramp island
- Pedestrian intersection lighting upgrades:
 - Westbound I-4 off ramp crosswalks
 - o Right turn lanes to westbound LB McLeod Road



Lighting upgrades include relocation of the light pole at the westbound I-4 off ramp island due to proposed widening. Pedestrian intersection lighting upgrades are planned at the westbound I-4 off ramp connection to John Young Parkway and at the intersection of southbound John Young Parkway and westbound LB McLeod Road.





Signalization and Communication Upgrades

- Upgrade signals with "Smart Signal" technology
- Enhance traffic flow and incident management capabilities by providing:
 - o Real-time data and video information to FDOT
 - o Ability to monitor and alert vehicle traffic
 - o Emergency management assistance
 - Connection to a statewide communication network

The proposed signalization upgrades include "Smart Signal" technology at John Young Parkway and the WB I-4 Ramp, Clear Way and LB McLeod signalized intersections.

The proposed Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) upgrades will enhance traffic flow and incident management capabilities by:

Providing real-time data and video information to FDOT, providing the ability to monitor and alert vehicle traffic, helping in emergency management, and connecting to a statewide communication network



Estimated Costs and Project Schedule:

• Design: \$600,000

Complete December 2021

• Construction: Estimated \$1.6 million

Begin summer 2022

All work will take place within existing FDOT right of way





Design is expected to be completed in December of 2021 at a cost of about \$600,000. Construction is expected to start in summer 2022 at an estimated cost of about \$1.6 million. All improvements will take place within the existing FDOT right of way.


