

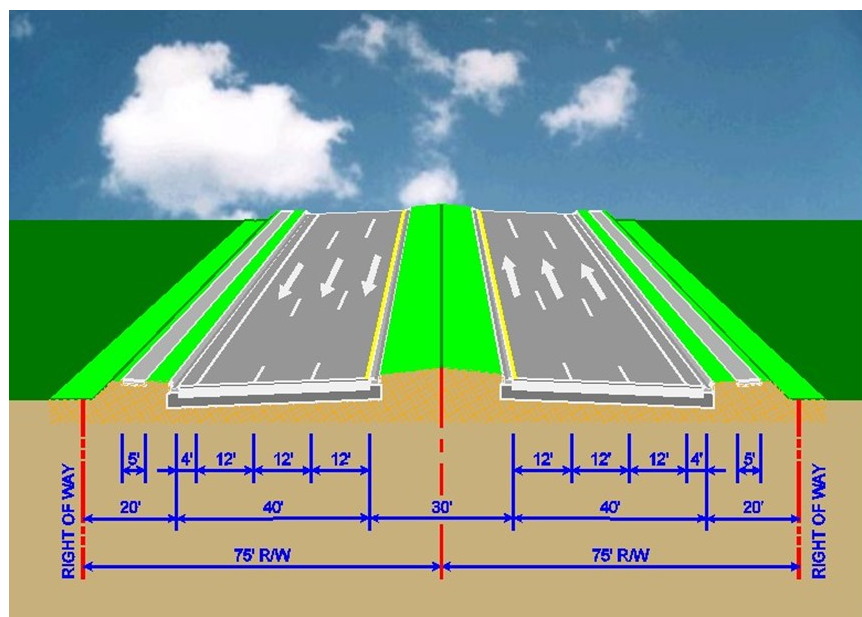
CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Five and Lane Construction Corporation are scheduled to begin a construction project on Colonial Drive in West Orange County. The project will widen and reconstruct Colonial Drive from 4 to 6 lanes. The project limits are from SR 429 to east of West Oaks Mall. The goal of this effort is to alleviate traffic and shorten travel times for motorists, as well as to provide for better access for residents and businesses. The project cost is approximately \$37.6 million. Construction is scheduled to begin in May 2015 with a completion date scheduled for summer 2017, weather permitting.

Additional work as a part of this project includes:

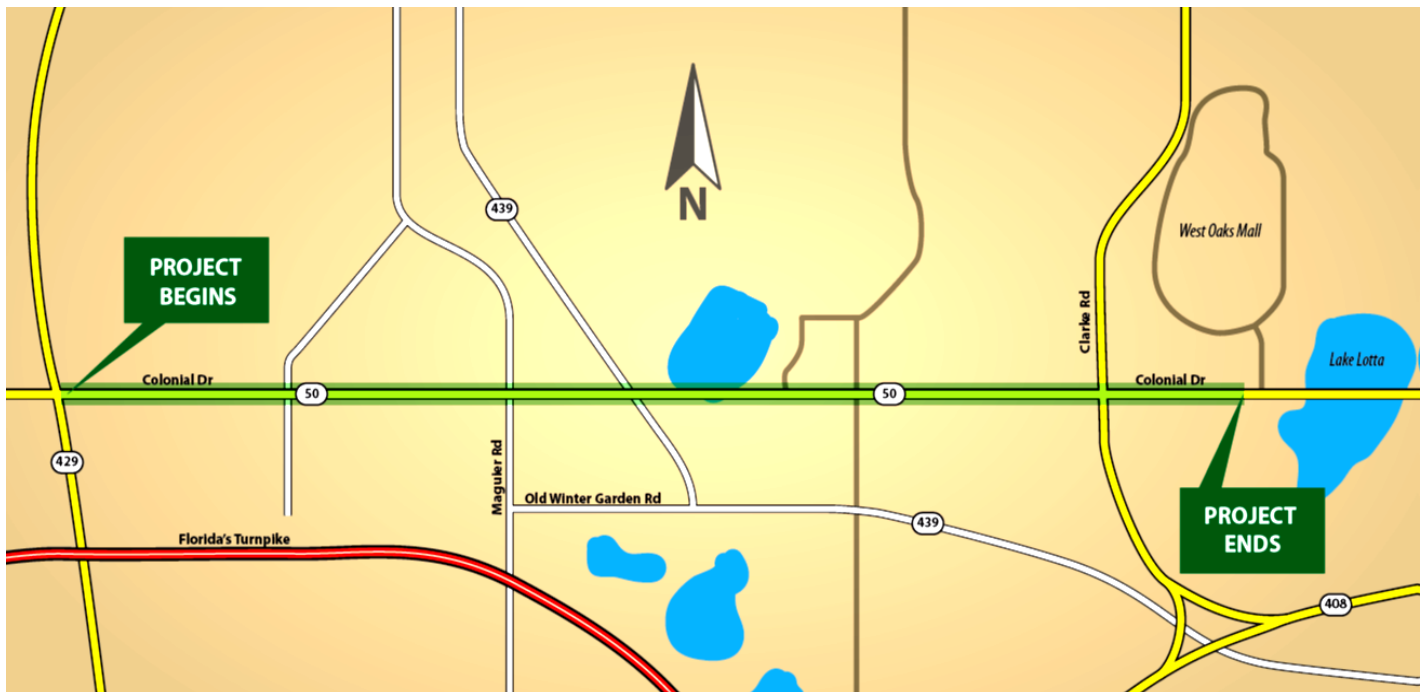
- Roadway lighting drainage, signing and pavement markings, signalization, milling and resurfacing, lighting and miscellaneous corrections and additions
- Twin bridge construction at Lake Bennet
- Addition of ponds and drainage structures
- Bicycle and pedestrian facilities
- Utility relocation and improvements to the City of Ocoee wastewater collection, wastewater transmission, reclaimed water distribution and water distribution systems.
