

Vehicle Storage & Maintenance Facility Sound Wall and Track Shift

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and SunRail are constructing a sound wall on the northeast side of the Rand Yard near the Vehicle Storage & Maintenance Facility (VSMF) in Sanford. The wall will be about 1,700 feet long and 22 feet high, and is designed to reduce noise levels for residents along Bristol Forest Trail in The Preserve at Lake Monroe subdivision, as well as the Central Florida Zoo. Work also will include shifting the existing mainline track to the northeast to accommodate construction of the wall between the mainline tracks and the VSMF.

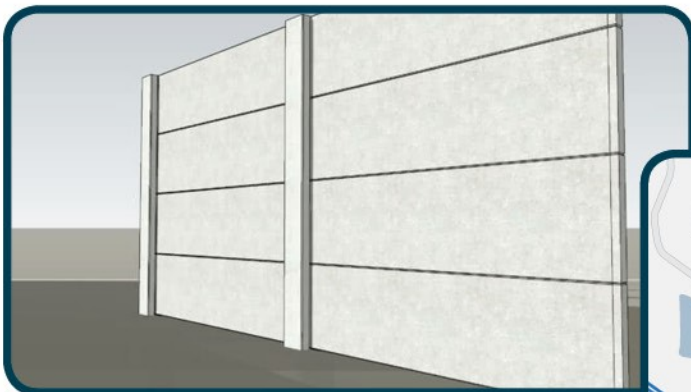
