



Roadway Stabilization Maintenance Project

State Road (S.R.) 25/U.S. 441 (½ mile south of the Alachua County line)
S.R. 35/Baseline Road (700 feet south of Northeast 24th Street)

Marion County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be injecting grout to stabilize the roadway at two locations as part of a maintenance project. The two locations are:

- U.S. 441 northbound about ½ mile south of the Alachua County line
- S.R. 35/Baseline Road southbound about 700 feet south of Northeast 24th Street

Lane Closures

There are no restrictions on U.S. 441 lane closures. However, motorists should expect only a single lane at-a-time to be closed for work. Lane closures may occur on Baseline Road at any time except between 2 p.m. and 6 p.m. Motorists should expect single lane closures at this location as well; however, most of the work will occur near the median. The project should take approximately two to three weeks to complete at each location.
