

Traffic Shifts and Detours Planned on U.S. 1 in Melbourne | MARCH 2020

Please be advised of upcoming, temporary traffic changes that will take place in your area beginning the week of March 22, 2020.

Traffic on northbound and southbound U.S. 1 will be shifted for a short distance to accommodate drainage work along the roadway.

Northbound and southbound traffic shifts will not occur at the same time. Southbound traffic will be shifted first. Once work is completed in the southbound lanes, the northbound traffic shift will take place. The traffic shifts will be in place for approximately one to two months in each direction.

SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC SHIFT

To accommodate work activities taking place on the west side of U.S. 1, southbound traffic will be directed to the northbound lanes beginning just north of Friendship Place on U.S. 1. Southbound traffic will be shifted back just south of Ernest Sands Road. Once work is completed on the west side of U.S. 1, the project team will reverse this process for work needed on the east side of U.S. 1.

SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC SHIFT DETOURS

There will be a detour in place for access to businesses and residences on the west side of U.S. 1. Drivers will be directed to make a U-turn just south of Ernest Sands Road for access to Friendship Place, Turner Road and Ernest Sands Road. Signs will be in place to direct drivers.

NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC SHIFT

To accommodate work activities taking place on the eastside of U.S. 1, northbound traffic will be directed to the southbound lanes beginning just south of Earnest Sands Road on U.S. 1. Northbound traffic will be shifted back to the northbound lanes. just north of Friendship Place.


