

State Road (SR) 518 (Eau Gallie Boulevard) from West of Mosswood Drive to East of Pineapple Avenue Resurfacing

Project Details

This project calls for the milling and resurfacing of State Road (SR) 518 (Eau Gallie Boulevard) from west of Mosswood Drive to east of Pineapple Avenue in Melbourne. The project also includes drainage work, curb and gutter construction, sidewalk reconstruction and upgrades to pedestrian crosswalk ramps to meet requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Additionally, there will be construction of a traffic separator and gravity wall, enhancements of highway lighting and signage, pavement markings and traffic signals.

The intersection of US 1 (North Harbor City Boulevard) and Eau Gallie Boulevard has been recently paved, so will not be resurfaced during this project.

Lane Closures

Project Location

Lane closures will be needed to complete the project. On Eau Gallie Boulevard east of North Harbor City Boulevard, lane closures will be permitted from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Thursday. West of North Harbor City Boulevard there are no lane restriction. Message boards and other signage will alert motorists to upcoming lane closures.


