Detour Planned on State Road 520/West King Street at Range Road Next Week

Brevard County – Motorists should be aware of a week-long detour on State Road (S.R.) 520/West King Street at Range Road next week.

The detour (see map attached) is necessary for crews to extend the drainage culvert to allow for construction of a sidewalk. This work is part of the Florida Department of Transportation's resurfacing and improvement project on S.R. 520/West King Street from Tucker Lane to Aurora Street.

To access Range Road from the east, motorists will need to travel north on Clearlake Road/S.R. 501 and then continue west on Lake Drive. From the west, drivers will need to travel north on Clearlake Road/S.R. 501 and then east on Lake Drive.

Businesses located on Range Road can be accessed via the detour. Message boards will also be in place to assist drivers.

The schedule is weather permitting and may change due to unforeseen circumstances. Check <u>www.CFLroads.com</u> for updates.
