



PUBLIC WORKSHOP ANNOUNCEMENT

SR 500 (US 192) at Wickham Road/Minton Road Intersection Improvement Project Brevard County, FL

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will conduct a public information workshop for the SR 500 (US 192) at Wickham Road/Minton Road intersection improvement project. We will present the design improvement with turn lanes for the intersection. The project will also include milling and resurfacing existing travel lanes on US 192 and Minton Road and replacing two new signal mast arms, new crosswalks and curb, and signing and pavement marking. This hearing is being conducted to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, design concepts, and social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements.

The workshop is scheduled for Wednesday March 22, 2017, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the West Melbourne City Hall located at 2240 Minton Rd, West Melbourne, FL 32904. The workshop will be an open-house, with display boards and an automated presentation showed from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. FDOT staff and the consulting team will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.
