

State Road (S.R.) 46 (West Main Street) and U.S. 1 (S.R. 5) **Brevard County**

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will resurface two sections of S.R. 46 (West Main Street) in conjunction with a project to resurface and improve drainage along U.S.1 in Mims. The work involved in this project includes:

Milling, resurfacing and improving drainage along S.R 46 from the Volusia County line to east of Carpenter Road.

Milling and resurfacing West Main Street from west of Palm Avenue to U.S. 1. This project also constructs sidewalk, provides a bike lane, improves drainage, and updates bus stops with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) features. Space Coast Transit Authority (SCAT) bus stops will remain accessible.

Milling, resurfacing and widening portions of U.S 1 from north of LaGrange Road to south of Minnie Lane (near Tractor Supply). This project also replaces sidewalk, provides a bike lane, updates bus stops and improves drainage. Installation of drainage structures will require modification to some driveways, but access will be maintained. Access signs will be provided if a business entrance is impacted by construction.

Lane Closures:

No lanes closures near signalized intersections between 6:30 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. or during student drop-off/pick-up times at Mims Elementary.


