

State Road (S.R.) 15 Milling and Resurfacing S.R. 15 (U.S. 441) from east of the bridge over Florida's Turnpike to north of Tyson Creek Bridge

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is milling and resurfacing State Road 15 (U.S. 441/South Kenansville Road) from east of the bridge over Florida's Turnpike to north of Tyson Creek Bridge. This project will also include widening to create a turn lane for South Canoe Creek Road, base work, highway signing, pavement markings, and other related construction.

Lane Closures and Work Schedule:

Work hours will typically be Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. During that time, motorists should expect lane closures/flagging operations.

Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to help alert traffic to upcoming closures. The flagging locations will also utilize temporary rumble strips as advanced warnings for those traveling in the area.

Motorists are advised to slow down and use extra caution while driving through the construction zone.
