



Florida Department of Transportation Interstate Lighting Improvements on I-75 Marion County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is installing new interchange lighting along Interstate 75 (I-75) at several locations in Marion County. The new lighting will be installed along the on and off ramps at each interchange, and underdeck lighting will be installed at each of the overpasses.

High-mast LED lighting will be installed at the following interchanges:

- I-75 at County Road (C.R.) 484 (Exit 341) in Summerfield
- I-75 at State Road (S.R.) 326 (Exit 358) in Ocala
- I-75 at C.R. 318 (Exit 368) in Reddick

Additionally, new conventional lighting will be installed along:

- S.R. 326 from east of I-75 to west of the railroad tracks; and
- C.R. 484 from Southwest 20th Avenue Road to I-75 on the north and south sides of the road and continuing to C.R. 475A (Southwest 16th Avenue) only on the north side of the road.

Work on the \$3.1 million project began in late November 2017 and is anticipated to finish in fall 2018.

Safety Information

In the event of lane closures or ramp closures along I-75, electronic message boards will be used to alert motorists. Work on S.R. 326 and C.R. 484 will require temporary closures of sidewalk. Pedestrians and bicyclists will be directed safely around work areas and are asked not to walk or ride through work zones.

FDOT reminds all road users to pay attention, drive with care and always buckle up.

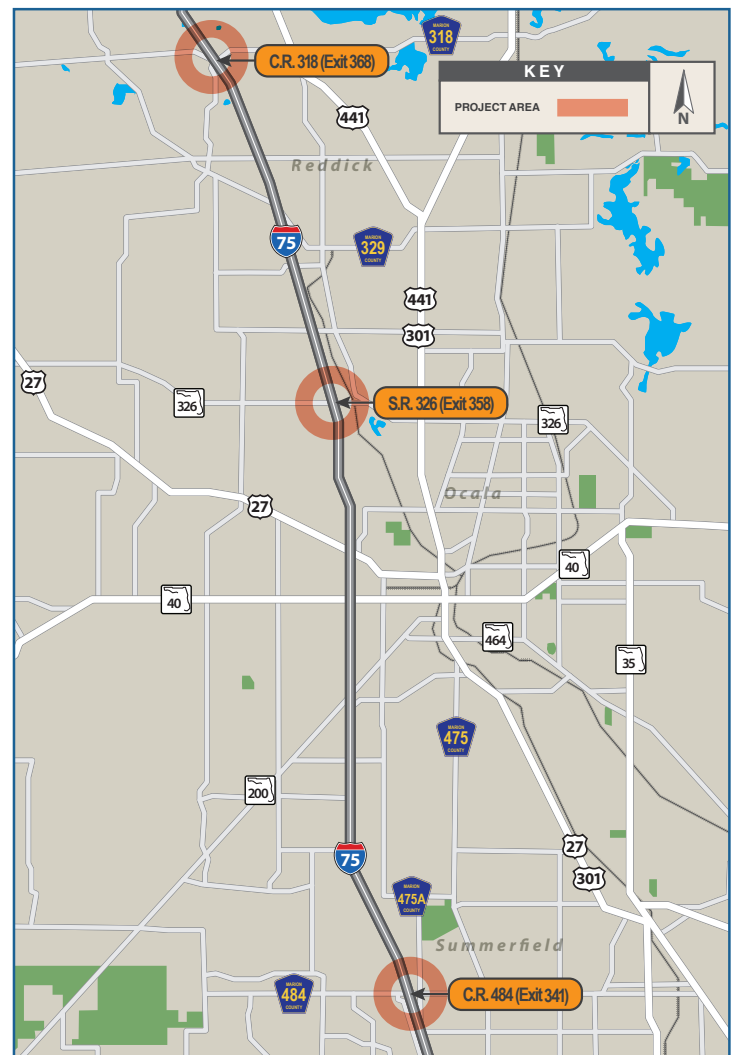
