Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be milling and resurfacing State Road 527 (Orange Avenue) from south of Lake Conway Drive (where Orange Avenue splits into one-way pairs) to north of Grant Street in Orlando.

This project will also include sidewalk curb ramp improvements that comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements, the installation of signing and pavement markings, pedestrian signal upgrades, minor drainage improvements and streetscape improvements.

The streetscape improvements will consist of constructing medians north of Pineloch Avenue and north of Illiana Street for future landscaping and building curb "bulb-outs" for parking and pedestrian enhancements.

Lane Closures

Nighttime lane closures are allowed on the project between 8:30 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists to upcoming closures. Access to businesses and/or residences will be maintained.

Motorists should use caution and be alert while driving through the construction zone.

Please note the schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions. Lane closure information can be found on the FDOT's Central Florida website, www.cflroads.com.
