



Kepler Road Pedestrian Bridge Painting/Rehabilitation

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be cleaning and painting the pedestrian bridge over Kepler Road at the department's Kepler Road office. Work also includes installation of a canopy on the bridge.



What to Expect During Construction:

Work may occur during the day and at night. Occasional single lane closures with flagging operations can be expected on Kepler Road between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. The speed limit will be reduced to 40 mph, and drivers are asked to use caution in the area.

Pedestrians traveling from the department's parking lot on the east side of Kepler Road to the main building will be directed to a designated crosswalk on Kepler Road, north of the existing pedestrian bridge. Additional visitor parking has been made available on the west side of Kepler Road in front of the building.

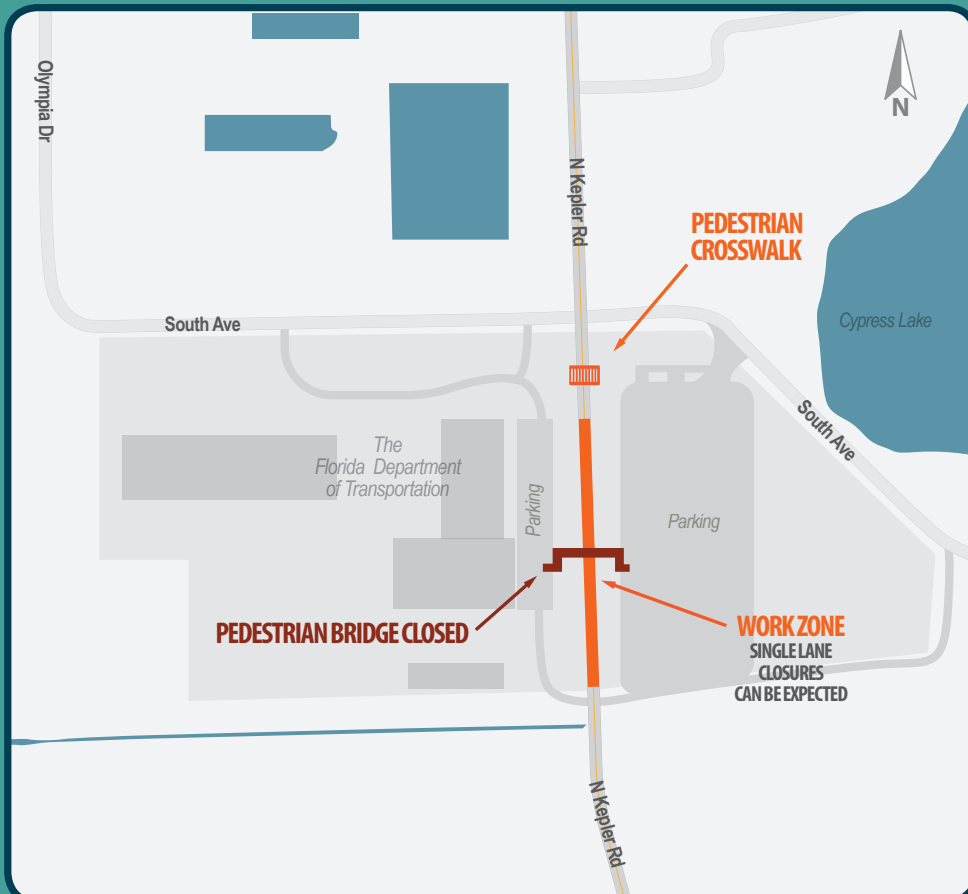
